High Average Singles	Al Wright	97.37% on 1,900 Targets
High Average Handicap	Carel Breytenbach	89.58% on 950 Targets

To become eligible for State Team consideration a minimum of 1500 Singles, 800 Handicap, and 800 Doubles targets must have been registered during the 2018 target year.
