GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the responsibility of the shooter to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident sub juniors, juniors & junior gold will be reduced by 50% provided no monies are played. They will be eligible for added monies.

- 1. Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
- 2. Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
- 3. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities of any and all accidents.
- 4. The MTA President, State ATA Delegate, and designees will act as a Commitee to rule on all disputes.
- 5. White Flyer Orange Top Pitch Targets will be thrown.
- 6. All Banks will be drawn at random. Event targets will be shot on 8 fields shooting 50 per field using the "Quick 50" format. Please bring two boxes of shells to the line.
- 7. The practice field will be open at 4pm Wednesday, July 13th and all subsequent tournament days from 8:00 am to 4pm. Practice rounds are \$7.00 per 25.
- 8. Trophies will be available for pick up each day. Trophies will not be mailed.
- 9. Cell phones and pagers not allowed on the line.

10.Campsites and RV parking are available on a first come first served basis. Sites include water but no power. Camper access is available on or after Saturday July 10th.

- 11.It is the shooter's responsibility to verify their scores on both the score sheets and score board. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed. However; scores will be corrected for record purposes.
- 12. Strict adherence to ATA and SF&G club rules regarding alcohol, drugs and eye and ear protection will be observed.
- 13. Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over by sub event to the next like event Ties in Handicap will be shot off.
- 14. Special category shooters must declare their category at time of classification and verify it is indicated on their receipt. Saturday's single classification will determine the High All Around Class.
- 15. To pre-squad please log on to www.PreSquad.com. Pre-Squad opened on May 13th and closes on June 17th at 11pm.
- 16. There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday between events for the purpose of electing the MTA Delegate and Alternate. All resident Maine shooters are encouraged to attend.
- 17. The Scarborough club has ammo available to sell shooters up to the amount they are shooting in this tournament. The cost is \$11.00 per box on a first come first served basis, until the stock is depleted.
- 18. Classification will be available Wednesday evening (July 13th) from 3pm to 7pm. Classification will begin at 7:30 AM on shoot days.

Classification

Classification will be based on the last 600 targets, total average or known ability, whichever is higher. Jim Montz, ATA Delegate, is chair man of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to see that their ATA card is correct and up to date. Falsified cards will result in disqualification. It is the shooters responsibility to make category declaration when classified.

Penalty

Shooters must have at least 500 singles, 500 handicap and 300 doubles in 2020, 2021, and 2022 target years combined to avoid penalty classification.

Adult male, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran and Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yard age, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies (1&2), Sub Juniors and Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However; said person will not be allowed to play purses or options and for feits all rights to added monies and trophies.
