It is our pleasure to dedicate our 2025 State Championships to Phillip Wright for the exemplary contribution he has made to trapshooting in Maine, the Northeast and Nationally.

Our Association especially thanks Phil for the many years he has supported our state championships as the shoot cashier. In that role, his suggestions and coordination of the many details of our state championships extend well beyond the cashiering function.

We often seek and appreciate his sound advice counsel and guidance related to Maine, Northeast and Zone ATA issues.



Phil has served as the 2002 ATA President, fifty years as the NH state ATA Delegate, is the current Treasurer of the Eastern Zone, and as past and present Treasurer of several local gun clubs of which he is a member. He currently coaches the MIT shooting team.

In 2011 he was inducted into the ATA Hall of Fame. His impressive shooting accomplishments, at the time of his induction, include having been named to 14 ATA, All American Trap Teams, including three times on the first team. From 1967 to 2008 he won 25 individual and team Grand American trophies,

including winning the 1977 Doubles Championship and the 1981 Champion of Champions title. From 1970 -1993 he won the Eastern Zone Singles Championship once, the Doubles Championship twice and the High All Around (HAA) title four times. In that time frame, he won 61 state titles, including 25 High All Around State Championships.

Be it trap shooting or organization service, Phil Wright is "ALL IN".

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the shooter's responsibility to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident sub juniors and juniors will be reduced by 50%, provided no monies are played.

1. Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
2. Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
3. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities for any and all accidents.
4. The MTA president, State ATA Delegate, and designees, will act as a Committee to rule on all disputes.
5. White Flyer Orange Top Pitch Targets will be thrown.
6. All banks will be drawn once a day so that all events that day will be shot on that rotation. Event targets will be shot on four banks of two traps each. The "Quick 50" format will be used at the discretion of shoot management and only if necessary.
7. The practice field will be open at 4pm on Wednesday, July 9th and during the tournament from 8am to 4pm. Practice rounds are priced at the Scarborough club's member rate of \$7.00 per round of 25.
8. Trophies will be available for pick up each day and will not be mailed.
9. Cell phones and pagers are not allowed on the line.

10. Campsites and RV Parking are available. Reservations are on a first come first serve basis. Sites include water but no power. Camper access is available July 7th to 14th. Gate codes will be provided. **Contact Tom Hartranft at 864-350-3781 or thartr4941@aol.com for reservations.**

11. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify their scores on both the scoresheets and the score board. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed. However, scores will be corrected for record purposes.

12. Strict adherence to ATA and SF&G club rules regarding alcohol, drugs and eye and ear protection will be observed.

13. Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over by sub event to the next like event. Ties in Handicap will be shot off.

14. Special category shooters must declare their category at the time of classification and verify it is indicated on their receipt. Saturday's single classification will determine the High All Around Class.

15. To pre-squad please log on to www.PreSquad.com. Pre-Squad opens on May 13th and closes on June 30th.

16. There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday between events for the purpose of electing the ATA delegate and Alternate(s). All resident Maine shooters are encouraged to attend.

17. The Scarborough club has ammo for sale to shooters up to the amount they are shooting in this tournament. The cost is \$10.00 per box on a first come first serve basis, until stock is depleted.

18. Classification will be available Wednesday evening (July 9th) from 3pm to 6pm.

Classification

Classification will be based on the last 600 targets, total average or known ability, whichever is higher. Robert Harris, Jr., ATA Delegate, is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to see that their ATA card is correct and up to date. Falsified cards will result in disqualification. It is the shooters responsibility to make category declaration when classified.

Penalty

Shooters must have at least 600 singles, 500 handicap and 400 doubles for 2023 and 2024 target years combines to avoid penalty classification.

Handicap

Adult male, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran and Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yard age, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies (1&2), Sub Juniors and Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However; said person will not be allowed to play purses or options and forfeits all rights to added monies and trophies.
